Bethel Bible Church has a rich history of loving God and people. Since its inception in 1964, this community of believers has met on Sundays for Sunday School and worship, and throughout the week for Bible Studies and various small group ministries. We are passionate about missions, supporting various missionaries worldwide, and sending some of our members to work in short-term missions in Mexico and Colombia. Our hearts are also invested in our own community, which is evident in our yearly Vacation Bible School, weekly Youth Group and Boys and Girls Clubs, and involvement in the Food Bank.

Our Sunday mornings begin with Sunday School for all ages, held from September until June, and culminating in our yearly Sunday School Picnic. During the summer, when we have no Sunday School program, we meet at 10 am for worship. From the Sunday after Labour Day until the third week in June, Sunday School begins at 10 am, and the worship service begins at 11.

Our worship service is a time of praise and worship to God, and a time of solid preaching that seeks to answer questions and teach timeless truths about who God is, how He works, and what He requires of us. The gospel (good news) is preached on a regular basis, explaining why Jesus Christ came and lived a perfect life, and why He died a horrible death on the cross, and how it affects people today. We provide a nursery for the little ones during this time.

During the week, we have Youth Group and B & G Club, as well as adult Bible Studies for men and women. We love to have newcomers join us in these meetings!

We also have a delicious Men's Breakfast about once a month, and we have a wonderful Ladies' Retreat from time to time.
