

From Trevor Johnson (HeartCry Missionary Society), who is based in Papua New Guinea along with his family. Here is their most recent Facebook post regarding the new Christian school starting up:

"The Lantern of Hope School in Danowage is in the process of launching. Their quality is much higher than the normal government-run schools in Papua. We had a team come out to test the students and 10 were selected for kindergarten and 10 for 1st grade and the rest will be taught in a non-formal setting.

We have 4 teachers presently and also a nurse coming. This will help us do medical clinic since this can become a tiring task.

Pray for the teachers. I am sure it will be difficult to adjust. Not all of the facilities are 100% finished. And many of the kids do not even have parents. And there is a lot of mud in the village at present. But there are always obstacles when embarking on any worthy endeavor. Pray for the perseverance of these teachers.

Also pray for several baptismal candidates that we have, including my daughter Alethea. She has professed faith for almost 2 years now.

And it is Perpetua's 6th birthday and Noah's 13th birthday this month. So pray that we can find time to celebrate these occasions adequately."
